

Fr Kelly's Reading Lists

Herbert Kelly was a voracious and catholic reader. During his time at Oxford he read extensively on a range of subjects far beyond his academic curriculum and he continued this practice for the rest of his life. In his diary for 1884, when he was working in his first parish, he lists ninety books that he read that year. As well as keeping lists of the books he read, he also made and kept copious notes on them. The SSM archives contains some 200 of these which provide a fascinating and revealing insight into the breath of his interests. For any researcher wishing to consider the influences on Kelly's religious formation, and his teaching and writing, an examination of these will provide rich material.

A list showing the range of Kelly's interest for the whole of his life follows below. The notes were made largely for his own information – a good scholar's way of interrogating and absorbing the material he is reading – and thus they rarely give dates although evidence in some of the notes may provide an indication. The full title, author's and publisher's details are also frequently lacking. There is, however, generally enough information for the diligent researcher to identify a work and, even if this is not the case, the titles alone provide a guide to the range of his interests, which included psychology, science, medicine, geography, history, philosophy and politics. Kelly also collected newspaper cuttings on a range of contemporary issues and book reviews.

The dates given after a work are the date of publication (or republication), the dates in square brackets are the dates when Kelly was reading the book and making notes – where this is known.
